## END OF LIFE TYRE AND WASTE COLLECTION

### TO BE LEGALLY COMPLIANT THESE ARE THE QUESTIONS YOU MUST ASK

1. Does your collector have a Waste Carrier's Licence?

**ALL USED TYRE COLLECTORS MUST BE REGISTERED CARRIERS**

2. Do they issue you with a Waste Transfer Note?

**BY LAW, ALL USED TYRE COLLECTIONS MUST BE RECORDED ON A WASTE TRANSFER NOTE**

3. Do your collected tyres go to a licensed recycling facility?

**BY LAW, ALL TYRES MUST BE TAKEN TO A FULLY LICENSED RECOVERY FACILITY**

4. Is your waste trail fully audited?

**YOU HAVE A STATUTORY DUTY OF CARE TO KNOW WHAT HAPPENS TO TYRES COLLECTED FROM YOUR PREMISES.**

It is very important you are able to tick 'Yes' with confidence to each of these four important questions. **IF NOT YOU MAY NOT BE LEGALLY COMPLIANT.**

TIF Responsible Recycler accredited collectors are audited annually to ensure:

- ✓ That they are correctly licensed
- ✓ That they issue customers with and maintain the correct paperwork
- ✓ That they maintain records of all their waste movements to final re-use, recovery or disposal
- ✓ That their sites are suitable, compliant and meet other appropriate standards e.g. health and safety
- ✓ That the end of life tyres they handle stay within the legitimate recovery chain.

We continue to work with our Environment Agency to ensure that the Responsible Recycler Scheme and its members meet the highest standards of regulatory compliance.
